Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 208 dated 07.06.2019 registered under Sections 302 read with Section 34 of IPC and subsequently added Section 397 and 120-B of IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no specific role attributed to the petitioner and even as per the MLR there are two injuries attributed. One is attributed to Vishal @ Vaishali and other is attributed to Shanti.

He further states that the allegations are false, the petitioner has been in custody since 11.06.2019 the challan has been filed and the charges have not been framed. Even Section 120-B IPC was added after the disclosure statement.

On the instructions from ASI Anand Kumar, learned State counsel has not disputed the fact regarding the custody period of the petitioner and further states that out of 25 witnesses none has been examined.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties. Since no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner and he has been in custody since 11.06.2019 and charges are yet to be framed, the trial will take time to conclude as out of 25 witnesses none has been examined and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
