The petitioner is the sole accused in FIR No. 0076 dated 25.9.2019 on the file of Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, registered under Sections 354-A IPC. By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, he seeks quashing of the said FIR.

The petitioner claims that the matter was duly compromised with the second respondent-complainant on 6.7.2020. An affidavit was executed on the same date by the second respondent stating to that effect and recording that she had no objection to the cancellation/quashing of the subject FIR.

Mr. P.S. Bhinder, learned counsel, entered appearance for the second respondent-complainant and filed his power of attorney. The same is taken on record. He confirmed the factum of compromise and reiterated that his client has no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, also raises no objection as no other case has been registered against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 0076 dated 25.9.2019 on the file of Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, and all proceedings pertaining thereto are hereby quashed.
