Petitioner-Jamila Begum has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.276 dated 26.11.2018, under Section 21 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a chronic diabetic patient and is also suffering from neurological disorder. According to learned counsel, the said disease was acquired by the petitioner somewhere in the year 2016. He prays that as the petitioner needs proper care, therefore, she be released for a period of two months on interim bail.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that no such ground of illness was raised by him in the previous petition bearing no.CRM-M-15286-2019, which was filed by the petitioner for regular bail and was dismissed on 22.07.2019. Even in the present petition, no supportive material has been placed on record. To a pointed query, learned counsel has submitted that he himself visited the doctor alongwith the prescription of the medicines being taken by the petitioner,

who opined that the said medicine is given to a patient who is having some neurological problem. Learned counsel is unable to give the particulars and details of any such consultation.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for grant of concession of interim bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
