The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.109 dated 16.06.2020, registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149, 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later) at Police Station Guru Harsahai, District Ferozepur.

The operative part of the order dated 26.08.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Inter alia contends that there is a delay of 13 days' in lodging the FIR in question as the occurrence is alleged to have been taken place on 03.06.2020, whereas, the present FIR was registered on 16.06.2020.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance

to the order dated 26.08.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation. It is further submitted that challan stands presented before the trial Court.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 26.08.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
