This civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by petitioner Sombir, aged about 35 years against respondents i.e. State of Haryana through its Addl. Chief Secretary, Department of Horticulture, Director General, Horticulture, Panchkula, Mission Director, Haryana State Horticulture Development Authority, Panchkula and the District Horticulture Officer, Charkhi Dadri seeking quashing of impugned order dated 09.06.2020 passed by respondent No.4-District Horticulture Officer, Charkhi Dadri for relieving the petitioner from the post of Peon after withdrawal of posts while seeking sanction of the said post, vide letter dated 30.06.2020 by replacing the petitioner with another contractual employee is against principle of law. In this writ petition, he is also seeking his reinstatement to the post.
