The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.6 dated 10.12.2018, registered under Section 302 IPC at Police Station Badli, District Jhajjar.

As per material brought on record, petitioner was found in the company of deceased Parveen, who left the shop of DJ system at about 12.10 a.m. The deceased was found present in the vehicle in which DJ system was installed. Prince PW-6 and Mohit PW-7 have been examined by the prosecution, who have

supported the case of the prosecution alleging that the petitioner and the deceased Parveen left their shop at about 12.10 a.m.

Since the last seen version has been witnessed by PW-6 and PW-7, therefore, the disclosure statement of the petitioner and the alleged recovery of rod, statement of Dr. Bijender Singh PW-4 and other prosecution evidence would be scanned by the trial Court in accordance with law.

In view of aforesaid, no case is made out at this stage for granting indulgence in favour of the petitioner. The petition stands dismissed.
