The petitioner in the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus and for appointment of a warrant officer with a roving writ to search for the detenues as mentioned in paragraph No.2 of the petition.

In the said paragraph it has been averred that the detenues namely Kala Singh, Jugraj Singh and Baljit Singh have allegedly been detained by respondent No.3.

The affidavit of the said respondent-SHO Karamjit Singh, Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga has been filed, wherein it has been averred that the alleged detenues were never apprehended by him nor are required in any case.

Counsel for the petitioner on the other hand submits that the said detenues have been released after issuance of notice of motion by this Court on 21.08.2020.

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Resultantly, it is apparent that the present petition has been rendered infructuous, in view of the stand of the State and the counsel for the petitioner and the same is disposed of as such.
