The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to respondents to grant him ACP on completion of 9 years of service and also to pass orders in respect of commutation of pension and to release other retiral benefits along with interest.

It has been submitted that although the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 28.2.2020 (Annexure P-12) but no order has been passed thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Director, Health and Family

Welfare Department, Punjab (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 28.2.2020 (Annexure P-12) in accordance with law at the earliest preferably within a period of 3 months from today. In case anything is found to be due, the same be paid to the petitioner within two months thereafter. Further, in case it is found that the petitioner is indeed entitled to the dues which have not been paid in time, the respondent-concerned shall consider payment of interest on the delayed payment.
