Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to furnish requisite court fee within a period of one week from today.

Application is disposed of.

CRM-W-820-2020

Prayer in the application is for placing on record the affidavit of petitioner No.1 in compliance of order dated 26.08.2020. Application is allowed.

Affidavit is taken on record.

Main case

Petitioner No.2-Alfa was married earlier to one Gurpreet Singh son of Sadhu Ram, who expired on 18.12.2019.

Vijay and Alfa, the petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against

the wishes of respondents no.4 to 9 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 9. They have placed on record Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-3, evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation, Annexure P-4 to the Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-4 and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
