It is stated that the petitioner was on interim bail. An exemption application was moved on his behalf on 04.12.2018, but the same was rejected and the bail was cancelled. Consequently, non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued. The absence was on account of the fact that the petitioner was unwell and, thus, the order of cancellation of bail is harsh. The petitioner wants to join the trial and he undertakes not to absent himself in future without the permission of the Court.
