The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.210 dated 23.06.2020 under Section 25-54-59 of Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 279, 307, 323, 336, 34, 427, 506 of IPC (later on Section 325 of IPC added and Section 427 of IPC omitted), registered at Police Station Yamuna Nagar Sadar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 26.08.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mehar Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 26.08.2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
