By way of present Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners are seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are major and have got married against the wishes of their parents and relatives. They are receiving serious threats and apprehend grave danger to their life and liberty. The petitioners had also sent a representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra for providing adequate security. However, no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Dimple Jain, AAG Haryana has joined the session through Video Conferencing and accepts notice for official respondents.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to the veracity of the contents of the petition and the submissions made by learned counsel

for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra to consider the representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary action as per law.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not, in any manner, be construed as an expression of the opinion on the veracity of the statement made by the petitioners or on the validity of their marriage and shall have no effect on any other civil or criminal proceedings, if any, instituted/pending against them.
