All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioners seek protection of life and liberty at the hands of respondents no.4 to 8, who are stated to be the father and other immediate relatives of petitioner no.1, upon them having married each other (as contended) against the wishes of the said respondents.

Pursuant to the order dated August 26, 2020, an affidavit has been filed by Mr. Rahul Bhardwaj, DSP, Sub-Division Abohar, District Fazilka, stating to the effect that the petitioners have got recorded their statements that the matter has been amicably settled between them and the private respondents.

filed for service of notice upon the private respondents, however, the petition dismissed having been rendered infructuous in view of the aforesaid statement made.
