Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail in case FIR No.31 dated 3.5.2014 registered under sections 307, 323, 324, 326, 379, 382, 148, 149, 201 I.P.C and sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station, Harike, District Tarn Taran.

During the course of arguments, it stands conceded by learned State counsel that co-accused Sukhwinder Singh, Kuldeep Singh, Avtar Singh and Sukhdev Singh have been granted benefit of bail by this Court vide orders appended as Annexures P-2 to P-5 along with the petition.

On the ground of parity itself and in the light of reasoning recorded by the Coordinate Bench in the order dated 12.12.2019 passed in **CRM-M-51732-2019** petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
