B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Learned counsel states that in view of stand in the reply filed, that supplementary challan would be filed expeditiously, he does not press the petition except for praying for directions to the respondents to submit the supplementary challan against the newly arrested accused, in a time bound manner.
3. Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, states that in case four weeks more time is granted, supplementary challan against newly arrested accused would be filed.
4. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to file supplementary challan against newly arrested accused within four weeks from today. However, it is made clear that in case the needful is not done within the stipulated period of time, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition.
