The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, so as to issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to act in accordance with statutory supply code regulations and pay interest to the petitioner on the amount required to be refunded as per order dated 01.03.2019 passed by Lok Pal (Ombudsman), Electricity, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the appeal filed by the petitioner has been allowed by the Lok Pal (Ombudsman), Electricity, Punjab, vide order dated 01.03.2019, but resultantly amount has not been released/refunded. Accordingly, the petitioner was constrained to file a representation dated 09.12.2019(Annexure P-4) addressed to the

The same is still pending before him without any decision thereof.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the respondent shall take a final decision on the representation dated 09.12.2019(Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner, preferably within a period of six months from today.
