The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 170, dated 06.07.2020, under Sections 407 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana

On 26th August, 2020 this court passed the following order:-

“The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a delay of 11 days in lodging of the FIR and that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He submits that the petitioner was nominated on the statement of coaccused Kuldeep Singh, who has already been granted concession of regular bail by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana vide order dated 21.07.2020.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present through conference call accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would be present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of

Arresting Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
List on 30.09.2020.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Surinder Singh submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the statement made, the order dated 26th August, 2020, is made absolute.
The petition stands disposed of.
