In the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents Nos.4 to 9 who are stated to be in-laws of petitioner No.1 and family members of petitioner No.2.

The petitioner No.2 is stated to be working as a Cook of mid day meal in a Primary School, as such the private respondents are demanding part of the money and on refusal of the same, petitioners are getting threats from the private respondents. Both the petitioners are married to each other.

This Court is of the considered opinion that if petitioner No.2 as such is not in a position to protect his wife from his own parents/her in-laws, it is not for the police to act on the representation dated 20.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) which has been allegedly given by them. It is inter se

dispute between the family members and it is not appropriate to the police to get into such dispute and on account of strained relationship inter se.

In such circumstances, no case is made for issuing any direction under extraordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court.

Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
