In the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents Nos.4 to 6, who are family members of petitioner No.1, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 15.08.2020 as per Sikh rituals at Shri Gurudwara Sahib, village Karni Khera, District Fazilka. The marriage certificate has been appended as Annexures P-3.

The date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 01.01.1999 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 01.01.1998 as per Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2).

A representation dated 15.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard. It is averred that petitioner No.1 is having agriculture land and is capable of looking after the petitioner No.2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. AS Sandhu, Additional AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the **Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
