This petition for regular bail has been filed by petitioner Paramjit Singh @ Prince Baba, aged about 23 years, an accused in FIR No.0132 dated 19.06.2019, for an offence under Section 379-B of IPC, registered with Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar.

Briefly stated facts of the case as per prosecution story are that the petitioner along with his co-accused had snatched Activa scooter having registration No.PB-08-CS-4339, a purse containing Rs.15,000/- and a silver chain from complainant Sahil Sharma by showing him a weapon like dater in the area of Railway Crossing Dakoha, GT Road, Jalandhar.

Notice of the petition was given to the State, which has put in appearance and is opposing the instant petition.

As per custody certificate filed by State counsel, the petitioner is involved in as many as 15 cases, out of which, he has been convicted in one case. The details thereof are as under:-
