With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing. -

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in case the respondents defer the enforcement of the on-line transfer policy (Annexure P-1) of Auction Records and Mandi Supervisors for three months, the petitioners' grievance would be satisfied.

Learned Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions, submits that the respondent-authorities undertake not to enforce the policy for a period of two months except viz.-viz. those who have already given their options and are willing to join at their new place of posting during the intervening period.

Looking to the aforesaid statement made by the learned Advocate General, Haryana and the prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioners, the undertaking and the statement of the learned Advocate General is accepted with

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modification that the period for which the transfer policy shall not be enforced is extended upto 30.11.2020, provided those petitioners, who wish to avail the benefit of relaxation shall move the necessary applications in this regard within a week from today.

With the aforesaid direction and observations, the petition filed by the petitioners stands disposed of.
