The instant Petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Anticipatory Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.131, dated 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2019, registered under

Sections 307, 506, 328, 148, 149, 323 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Bass, District Hisar.

2. Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner has drawn attention of the Court to the Order passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CRM-M No.13796 of 2020 – 'Rajbir Singh vs. State of Haryana'** on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 vide which co-accused-Rajbir Singh, who stands on a similar footing with the Petitioner was directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court in view of the fact that he had been Declared a Proclaimed Offender, and it was observed by the Co-ordinate Bench that otherwise on merits it was a fit case for grant of Anticipatory Bail.

3. The present Petitioner stands on a same footing to that of his co-accused-Rajbir Singh.

4. As such, the Petitioner now directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within a week from today after which an appropriate order on his Application for Bail, if so filed, shall be passed by the Ld. Trial Court expeditiously.
