The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.131 dated 12.07.2019, under Sections 307, 506, 328, 148, 149, 323 and

120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Bass, District Hisar, Haryana.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of the Court to the statement of the victim/complainant recorded by the Police, in which he had stated that the petitioner along with co-accused Rajbir had given *lathi* blows on his hands. Several of the co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court earlier.

3. As such, considering the role attributed to the petitioner as revealed in the complainant's statement noted above and taking into account the fact that by now he has already undergone detention well in excess of one and a half months, since 17.07.2020, as also considering the fact that the trial is likely to take its own substantial time to complete on account of the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, the prayer of the petitioner for releasing him on regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
