The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.1088 dated 22.11.2019 on the file of Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat, registered under Sections 307, 323, 452 and 34 IPC along with Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959. By way of this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., he seeks grant of anticipatory bail.

The petitioner is stated to have fired a gun and the bullet struck the complainant on his left shoulder. The bullet was retrieved but the gun is yet to be recovered. The charge framed is one under Section 307 IPC. In the light of the seriousness of the allegation made and the specific overt act attributed to the petitioner, this Court sees no grounds to grant the petitioner the benefit of pre-arrest bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
