Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.601 dated 26.11.2019 under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 70% physically handicapped person and in the FIR, registered at the instance of Sandeep Kumar, it is alleged that in November, 2018, the petitioner enticed him and took Rs.50,000/- for helping in procuring the loan of Rs.10.00 lacs. Similarly, there are certain other complaints against the petitioner for taking small amounts of Rs.9,000/-, Rs.10,000/- and Rs.5,000/- from other persons for helping them in taking the widow pension and loan etc. It is further submitted that on account of some money dispute, the complaints have been registered

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against the petitioner; he is in custody since 06.03.2020; he is not involved in any other case; challan has already been presented; offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate, therefore, it will take long time in conclusion of the trial.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position, however, submits that allegations against the petitioner are that he has taken money from the complainant and some other persons mentioned in the FIR, for providing his services, however, he has failed to fulfill his commitment and further failed to return the amount. It is also not disputed that the petitioner is 70% physically handicapped person and is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
