Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.30 dated 11.02.2019 under Sections 15 and 25 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Moga.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to pursue the present petition. He further submits that omissions are there with regard to the nature of offence allegedly committed by the petitioner and about his medical record having not so been produced and therefore, he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition.

In view of the request so made, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn.

However, at this stage, it has also been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the jail authorities are not giving any document relating to the medical ailment and treatment taken by the petitioner while his detention in the jail.

In view of the submissions so made, to facilitate the petitioner to seek legal remedy, direction is hereby given to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot to furnish copies of the medical record to the petitioner within seven days on receipt of certified copy of this order. Copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot.
