The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This Civil writ petition under Articles 226, 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned transfer order dated 21.08.2020 (Annexure P-1).

In terms of the State Govt. Transfer Policy (Annexure P-2), the petitioner has moved a representation dated 06.08.2020 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the respondent No. 2, to consider and decide the representation dated 06.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) within stipulated period. He further submits that father of the petitioner is a

known patient of Cancer and is undergoing treatment in local Hospital at Panchkula.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has already been handed over to learned State counsel.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Directorate of Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Sector-2 Panchkula to consider and decide the representation dated 06.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) sympathetically and expeditiously preferably within two weeks from today. Till then, the operation and effect of the impugned transfer order dated 21.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) shall remain stayed.
