This petition is for quashing the impugned order dated 20.05.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patti, declaring the petitioner a proclaimed offender in case bearing FIR No. 31 dated 03.05.2014 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 326, 379, 382, 148, 149, 201 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Harike, Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 28.08.2020, passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has appeared before the learned trial Court 07.09.2020, who admitted the petitioner on bail.
