Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned State counsel submits that since the petitioners have approached the police authority and suffered a statement that they are not apprehending any threat to their life and liberty, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is rendered as infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
