The petitioner seeks cancellation of regular bail in a petition filed under Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 206 dated 17.07.2020 under Sections 420, 506, 406 IPC, P.S. Mandi Gohindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

It is apparent that the petitioner has a remedy as such to approach the same Court for the said relief under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. The said Section may provide the powers to be concurrent as such but since the said Court was seized and dealing with the matter, in the opinion of this Court, it would be more appropriate if the petitioner is aggrieved, he should approach the said Court at the first instance.

Faced with this situation, counsel submits that he does not press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same with liberty to approach the same Court at the first instance.
