The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.0185 dated 03.08.2020 on the file of Police Station City 1, Abohar, District Fazilka (Punjab), registered under Sections 458, 307, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959. By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., he seeks transfer of the investigation in the said case from out of the range of Fazilka.

The Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur, filed a reply stating that earlier, by order dated 25.09.2020, he had constituted a Special Investigation Team comprising the Superintendent of Police (PBI), Ferozepur, and the Deputy Superintendent of Police

(Investigation), Fazilka, to look into this case but in the light of the prayer made by the petitioner, he had passed order dated 03.10.2020, re-constituting the Special Investigation Team. In consequence, the team now consists of the Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Ferozepur, and the Deputy Superintendent of Police (Crime Against Women and Children), Ferozepur.

In the light of this development, whereby the investigation in the case would now be undertaken by the officials of Ferozepur Range, Mr. K.B. Raheja, learned counsel for the petitioner, states that no further orders are required.

The petition is accordingly dismissed as infructuous.
