Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.133, dated 02.08.2020, under Section 61(1) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Having argued the matter at some length and upon sensing that this Court was not accepting the prayer, counsel seeks withdrawal of the petition.

He, however, seeks indulgence of this Court and undertakes that the petitioner would be ready and willing to surrender and if an application for bail is filed thereafter, directions be issued for deciding the same forthwith.

As per submission made by counsel, instant petition is disposed of as not pressed.

It is, however, observed that in case petitioner duly surrenders within a period of five days from today and thereafter files an application for bail, the competent Court would decide the same in accordance with law and would make an endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously.
