The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.0112 dated 11.06.2020 on the file of Police Station Sangat, Bathinda, District Bathinda, registered under Sections 365, 342, 325, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC. By way of this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., he seeks grant of anticipatory bail.

Perusal of the FIR reveals that the complainant attributed specific overt acts to the petitioner in the attack made upon her on 10.06.2020. He is alleged to have caught hold of her by her arms and forcibly dragged her, apart from inflicting a blow on her left leg with a rod.

In the light of the seriousness of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, this Court sees no grounds made out to extend him the benefit

of pre-arrest bail. The co-accused who were granted anticipatory/regular bail do not stand on the same footing as the petitioner, in the light of the specific allegations made against him by the complainant.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
