Application is allowed as prayed for. Reply and Annexure R-1 are taken on record.

Main case:

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to produce Komal, daughter of the petitioner, from the alleged illegal detention of respondents No.4 to 12 and to take legal action against respondents No.4 to 12.

Vide order dated 04.09.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner, as also respondent No.4 and alleged detenue-Komal, daughter of the petitioner, had been directed to appear before the Station House Officer, Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 04.09.2020, the petitioner has met with his daughter-Komal in the police station. He further states that though Komal- daughter of the petitioner is minor, yet she has happily married respondent No.4.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.
