In this writ petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* to direct respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also to direct respondent Nos.4 to 9 not to harass them. Besides, a further prayer has also been made for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation filed by the petitioners expeditiously.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 24.8.2020 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate action.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG., Punjab who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali to look into the representation dated 24.8.2020 (Annexure P-6) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
