The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.134, dated 2.7.2020, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith another accused was found in conscious possession of 14000 intoxicated tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride, a prohibited substance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has clear antecedents and he has been falsely implicated in the present case and he is a first time offender.

On the other hand, on the directions of the Court, reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, has been filed, pointing out that the recovery from the petitioner and another co-accused falls in the category of commercial quantity.

A report from the Forensic Science Laboratory has been received, confirming the presence of prohibited substance.

In view of the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant bail to the petitioner is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
