The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.34 dated 18.05.2018 registered under Sections 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station GRP Sonapat.

As per case of the prosecution, a dead body lying in Sonapat Railway Yard was recovered. The entire case of the prosecution is based upon deposition of two alleged eye-witnesses namely Bijender and Ram Niwas.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of the Court to the statements of Bijender and Ram Niwas to contend that they have not supported the case of the prosecution.

Mr. Chetan Sharma, AAG, Haryana does not dispute this fact. The petitioner is in custody since May, 2018.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the conclusion of trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
