The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 or any other person from interfering in the married life of the petitioners.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are major by age. They have performed marriage by going against the wishes of their family members. Hence, they apprehend the danger to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and Mr. R.V.S. Chugh, Advocate put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 to 8.

The counsel for the respondents have submitted that since the petitioners have performed the marriage, therefore, respondents have no concern with the life of the petitioners now. They have no intention to cause any harm to either of the petitioners, therefore, the allegation against them that the petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty from respondents No. 4 to 8 is totally baseless.

In view of the above, this court does not find any material to presume threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
