The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner-Naman Luthra, stated to be aged 20 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his family from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner based on pleadings submits that respondent No.4 also lives near the house of the petitioner. He then submits, by making reference to paras 5 and 6 of the petition, that respondent No.4 in connivance with respondents No. 5 and 6 create harassment to the petitioner and his family members, including the ladies in the house. It is alleged that they used dirty language and inspite request, they did not stop, rather used dirty language. Learned counsel, however, submits that in this regard, a detailed representation dated 20.05.2020 (Annexure P-3) was submitted to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.

Mr. P.S. Walia, Asstt. A.G., Punjab, who has joined proceedings on service of advance copy of the petition, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner approach the police authorities concerned with above representation dated 20.05.2020 (Annexure P-3) with regard to the alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Gurdaspur-respondent No.2, expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Gurdaspur-respondent No.2, by the Registry through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.
