The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to take action and remove respondents No.4 to 15 from their respective posts in consonance with the provisions of Section 14(e) of Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 by abusing/misusing their respective posts by continuously disapproving the budget for the financial year 2020-21, due to which supply of necessary services has been disrupted/affected.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that his complaint/representation dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-6) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. AG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that respondents will look into the matter and will decide the complaint/representation of the petitioner. Let a complete copy of the paper book be supplied to the State counsel on whatsapp or through e-mail during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the complaint/representation dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
