This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. Seeking benefit of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.106 dated 23.12.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 and 201 of IPC registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

During the course of arguments it stands conceded by learned State counsel that co-accused Deepak and against whom there were similar allegations has been granted benefit of bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 03.03.2020 in CRM-M-6622 of 2020.

On the ground of parity itself and by adopting the same reasoning contained in the order dated 03.03.2020 in CRM-M-6622 of 2020, present petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali.
