Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.637 dated 27.07.2020 registered under Sections 120-B, 148, 149, 302 IPC at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the complainant Pritam Singh had given an information to the police that in the morning he got the information that his nephew namely Manpreet @ Sonu aged 29 years was lying in an injured condition with head injury in Tau Devi Lal Complex Street near Sai Tower and when he reached at the spot, he saw that his nephew was lying dead with head injury and the blood was scattered. In the complaint given to the police, he has named the petitioner as one the suspect, along with other persons, who had heated exchange of words previously with the deceased.

Counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that, in fact, the complainant has given the name of the petitioner of his own and

there is no eyewitness to the occurrence.

Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is appearing through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of respondent – State.

Counsel for the State, however, opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the petitioner is named in the FIR/complaint and the motive is also given that on a previous occasion, there was a heated exchange of words with the accused persons including the petitioner and the deceased Manpreet @ Sonu.

In view of the above, considering the gravity of offence, I find no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
