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been made for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 4 to conduct fair, transparent inquiry/investigation in case FIR No. 161 dated 03.06.2018 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of Prize Chits and Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act 1978, Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala and also take appropriate legal action against respondents No. 5 to 11.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that cancellation report presented before the Illaqa Magistrate in the above-noted FIR was accepted in December, 2018.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives in the present petition.

Dismissed as infructuous.
