Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.90 dated 07.08.2020, registered at Police Station Nandgarh, Bathinda, District Bathinda, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

On 28.08.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 24.11.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 28.08.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mehnga

Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.08.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
