The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction to the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as per Regularization Policy issued by the Government on 01.10.2003 alongwith consequential benefits.

It is contended that the petitioner herein is working as Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar since 2000 and has given many representations to the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as per Govt. notification dated 01.10.2003. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation/legal notice dated 20.03.2020 should be decided expeditiously.

At this stage, Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts

notice on behalf of all the respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and decide the representations/legal notice of the petitioner.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation/legal notice dated 20.03.2020 of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
