GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Sarvjeet Kaur and Sachin Kumar, stated to be aged 38 & 23 years respectively, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 & 4 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 had got married to respondent No.5 in the year 2009 and two children aged about 10 years & 08 years, are born from the wedlock. It is alleged in the petition that husband of petitioner No.1 use to beat her daily after consuming liquor. In this regard, she had earlier also submitted representation to the Women Cell. It is then submitted by counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.1 had decided to live with petitioner No.2. It is also submitted by counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.1 would take legal remedy in accordance with law, however, as of now she has made a prayer in the present petition for issuance of directions to respondents

No.3 & 4 for protection of life and liberty of petitioner No.1 herself, her two children and petitioner No.2.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard, a detailed representation dated 10.06.2020 (Annexure P-4) was submitted to the Station House Officer, Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.4).

Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Goel, DAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings on service of advance copy of the petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned, with above representation dated 10.06.2020 (Annexure P-4) with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Station House Officer, Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.4) as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Station House Officer, Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.4), by the Registry through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Needless to say that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards the validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
