The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail for two months to the petitioner in case FIR No.19 dated 25.01.2020, under Sections 306, 452, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Gurugram, Haryana on the ground that he is a positive case of Corona Virus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner herein was taken into custody in the aforesaid FIR on 11.08.2020. It is submitted that the petitioner is a positive case of Corona Virus and at present, he has been quarantined in polyclinic Sector 31, Gurugram,

therefore, interim bail for two months be allowed to him

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, admits to the factum that the petitioner is a positive case of Corona Virus.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the petitioner is a positive case of Corona Virus, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail for a period of two months on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Needless to say, the petitioner shall not try to contact the complainant in any manner whatsoever either directly or indirectly.
