The petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent no. 2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty. Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that a complaint in the Women Cell was pending which has now been referred to the Assistant Commissioner of Police for enquiry.
