The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation.

The grievance of the petitioner is that her daughter, namely, Gurpreet Kaur, aged about 25 years was kidnapped in full public view on 20.08.2020. Even though the FIR No.326 dated 21.08.2020 under Sections 356, 366, 452, 506 and 149 IPC, Police Station Zirakpur, has been registered, but no action has been taken by the police, seemingly because the accused are highly influential and well connected persons. Representation has been made by the petitioner to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, which is placed on record as Annexure P-2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harbir Singh Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, made appearance on behalf of the respondents.

The present petition is disposed of with the direction to

respondent No.3 to look into the matter and to ensure that action is taken in accordance with law vis-à-vis the investigation of the aforesaid FIR.

However, these observations of mine are circumscribed only for the purposes of disposal of the present petition and shall not be construed as expression on merits relating to the contents of the aforesaid FIR or any other civil or criminal proceedings, if any, pending between the parties concerned.

Certified copy of this order be also sent to the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police, for necessary compliance.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
