In this writ petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* to direct the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members. Besides, a further prayer has also been made for directing respondent No.3 to decide the representation filed by the petitioners expeditiously.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 17.8.2020 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate action.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Samina Dhir, DAG., Punjab who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation dated 17.8.2020 (Annexure P-3) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
